"If you have dollars in your pocket and out of debt, your position is strong". That was one of the more dominant points brought out in a speech to the Business and Professional Women's Club by Dr. Martin this month. The title was "Money in Your Pocket".

Figures showed their way into the speech in two important respects. (1). The amount of money in circulation at the present is the lowest since 1945. (2). Unemployment is mounting and that because money, cash is the thing now that counts.

Dr. Martin was of the opinion that if inflation hit the country it would not be destructive. The reasons he gave for this belief were: Large government spending. Spending can be stepped up at will, farm prices will be supported, wage rates will be sustained, money supply is immense and will be so will large expenditures by government, savings are large and that the social insurance will have a crushing effect.
