Scientia et Humanitas, MTSU's peer and faculty reviewed journal of student research, is seeking unpublished graduate and undergraduate papers from students in all disciplines for the 2015-16 issue. The journal invites submissions from all current MTSU students and recent graduates working independently or in collaboration with other students or with a faculty mentor.

Submissions should consist of approximately 10 – 30 typed, double spaced pages (including works cited), and may include, but are certainly not limited to, revised and edited manuscripts based on papers presented for classes, conferences, Scholars Week, the Social Sciences Symposium, or chapters of theses or dissertations. Papers must be accompanied by a brief abstract of no more than 250 words stating the purpose, methodology, results, and conclusions of the research. Researchers should employ the currently accepted standard citation format for major publications in their discipline.
